The vast majority of Mongolians live in one-room tents, with over half of the population under 23 lacking in personal development. Existing Christians struggle with limited leadership and resources for spiritual growth.

Mongolia's cultural openness and religious tolerance foster exploration of new beliefs, including Christianity. The receptive youth and strong community bonds support the spread of the gospel.



THE BAD:

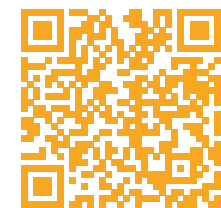
Huge language barriers, materialism and a nomadic lifestyle pose challenges to establishing and growing consistent Christian communities.
